President Tim Voelker opened with devotions. He used the August 6 Lutheran Hour Ministries devotion with the theme—Do We Give God Credit?" Pastor Snow was unable to attend due to a family funeral.

We then had introduction of the 15 present.

The minutes of the April Board Meeting were approved as corrected. Tim is not a pastor.

John Johnson mentioned the need for speakers to speak and make presentations in behalf of the LLL at Rallies and other events. He also urged us to use the many things on the internet.

John urged us to get him articles for the Reporter. Also, he would like help especially a writer for the Reporter. Articles are due now.

We then discussed the District Convention. Region 2 will host the Convention at Holy Cross, Wichita on November 11 and 12. Kurt Buchholz, Executive Director of Lutheran Hour Ministries will be our special guest presenter and speaker. There will be no banquet. Instead we will eat and be entertained by members from Holy Cross. More information will be in the LLL Reporter.

Tim gave a report on the LLL Golf event. \$841 was raised for the District Project. Mark Nieman, Nortonville, will chair the golf event for 2017.

Notes from Polly: This fall a DVD "This is the Life" with Bible Study guide is coming out. At this time there are 64 groups with 886 people using Men's Network material. A different DVD coming out this fall is entitled A Man Named Martin and a new Muslim DVD; also urge people to get Affiliated group status. We have 3 new Lutheran Hour Ministry offices, namely, Turkey, Laos and Mongolia and are working on Egypt. We have Ministry Centers in 34 countries.
